

Fort Bliss Pool Rule and Facility Regulations

1. Individuals with any communicable disease, skin ailment or open wound are restricted from the pool.
2. All swimmers will take a cleansing soap shower prior to entering the pool.
3. **Proper swim wear is required. No cut-offs, basketball shorts, or thong bikinis. T-shirts will only be allowed if they are white or grey. (No offensive language or graphics).**
4. No running.
5. No diving from the sides in shallow water.
6. No horseplay.
7. No profanity.
8. No swimming in slide areas.
9. Only one person on the water slide at a time.
10. No pets allowed.
11. No glass cups or containers.
12. **Consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs of any kind are not allowed inside the pool area to include the parking lot.**
13. **Coast Guard approved life jackets, kickboards, and exercise equipment is allowed provided they are not inflatable. The utilization of any inflatable flotation device not provided by the pool is strictly forbidden to include water wings, rings, etc.**
14. Infant strollers must have locks on the wheels and must be attended by the parents at all times. Infants must wear rubber pants over diapers or swim diapers if they enter the water.
15. Pool will be cleared every hour for a period of 10 minutes for safety purposes. In the event of extreme crowding the pool may be cleared every hour for 15 minutes at the discretion of the lifeguard in charge. Adults and lap swimmers may remain in the pool during the breaks.
16. All patrons are subject to lifeguard safety instructions.
17. Personal conduct must be in accordance with standards of good taste, common courtesy, and conducive to a family atmosphere.
18. One parent/adult (18 years or older) per six children.
19. No entry fees may be collected by renter. (Private functions.)
20. Patrons must be 13 years old or older to stay by themselves. AR 215-1, para 7a.
21. Children of kindergarten age and older will use gender appropriate showers, locker rooms, and bathrooms. AR 215-1, para 7c.
22. Violation of any of the above regulations may result in removal from the facility and possible further disciplinary action. Continued violations may result in the patron(s) being banned from the facility.
