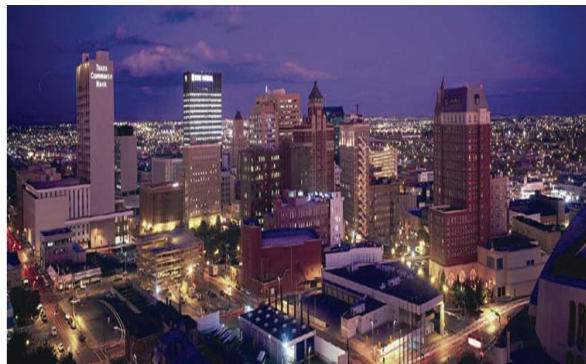
Information Orientation
